Dear Kip,

In response to your recent requesting information about our ancestors, I am afraid that I have never made a genealogical ~~study~~ but I will be happy to give you what information I do have.

The Wylies came from Scotland and settled in Tioga County, Pennsylvania.

Your greatgrandfather, Daniel B. Wylie was born on July 14, 1827 in Tioga County or Susquehanna, Pennsylvania. He was a physician and practiced medicine in Tioga County. He moved to Grand Rapids and finally to Wausau, Wisconsin where he practiced for 40 years.

Your greatgrandmother, Harriet Ansbery, daughter of Truman Ansbery was born in Tioga County. She graduated from medical school (a rather rare event in those days) and practiced medicine in Wausau and Merrill, Wisconsin.

Your grandfather, Winfred (Win) Wylie was born on August 8, 1855 at Wylie's Landing, Marathon County, Wisconsin. He received his primary education in Wausau, Wisconsin, his college education in Lawrence College of Appleton, Wisconsin and his M.D. degree in Rush Medical College in Chicago. He later attended Atlanta Law School from which he obtained his law degree. He came to Phoenix in 1896 when Arizona was still a territory and was named Territorial Surgeon by two governors. He practiced medicine in Phoenix until his death in 1939.
